<b>What is the overall deductible?</b>	\$0	See the Common Medical Events chart below for your costs for services this plan covers.
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?</b>	Not Applicable.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
<b>What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?</b>	Premiums, health care this plan doesn't cover, and services indicated in chart starting on page 2.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.

This plan uses a provider network. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network.
