

## 2020 Flu Shots Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. Why does Northrop Grumman provide flu shots at no cost for employees?

Your health and well-being is a top priority at Northrop Grumman. Getting an annual flu shot is a quick, easy and important way we can lower our risk of becoming ill and infecting others this flu season. This is even more important this year during the COVID-19 pandemic.

### 2. Is Northrop Grumman providing on-site flu shots this year?

This year, there will be no flu shots administered at Northrop Grumman facilities as a safety precaution. The need for social distancing and other preventive measures against the pandemic make it difficult to host large on-site gatherings.

### 3. What are my options to get a free flu shot, since there will not be on-site flu shots administered at my Northrop Grumman facility or location this year?

This year, you have two options to get a flu shot at no cost:

- **If you are an active Northrop Grumman employee**, print a [CVS flu shot voucher](#) and redeem it at a participating CVS Pharmacy. The voucher is valid from Sept. 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021. One voucher per employee.
- **If you are enrolled in a Northrop Grumman medical plan**, you can also get your flu shot from your health care provider or any other location that accepts insurance, including many pharmacies.

### 4. How do I redeem the CVS flu shot voucher?

Print the [CVS flu shot voucher](#) and bring it with you to a participating CVS Pharmacy. This includes CVS Pharmacy locations, Longs Drugs®, Navarro® and CVS Pharmacy at Target. Note that the voucher cannot be used at MinuteClinic®. Print your name and sign where indicated on the form. Your flu shot cannot be processed if you don't bring the voucher.

### 5. I don't participate in a Northrop Grumman medical plan. Where can I get a flu shot at no cost?

Visit a CVS Pharmacy and present the printed [CVS flu shot voucher](#). It will be paid by the company.

### 6. I am enrolled in Northrop Grumman's Anthem medical plan. Where can I get a flu shot at no cost?

As an Anthem member, you have three options to get a flu shot:

- Visit a CVS Pharmacy and present the printed [CVS flu shot voucher](#).
- Visit any health care provider that participates with Anthem and present your medical ID card. Visit [Anthem.com](#) or use [Engage](#) to locate a participating provider.
- Visit one of more than 60,000 pharmacies that participate in CVS' Broad Vaccination Network and present your prescription card and a valid ID. Or, provide your date of birth and the pharmacy can look you up. Visit [Caremark.com](#) or download the CVS Caremark app to find a vaccine pharmacy in your network. It includes many national chain pharmacies.

**7. I participate in Northrop Grumman's Kaiser medical plan. Where can I get a flu shot at no cost?**

Visit a CVS Pharmacy and use the [CVS flu shot voucher](#) or visit a Kaiser facility to get your flu shot.

**8. Can my spouse/domestic partner and children also get a flu shot at no cost?**

If your family members are covered under a Northrop Grumman medical plan, they can visit their health care provider or show their CVS card at a participating pharmacy for a no-cost flu shot under their preventive benefit. Spouses, domestic partners and children are not eligible under the voucher program.

**9. I'm a contractor. Can I get a flu shot at no cost?**

While you cannot get a flu shot under Northrop Grumman's benefit, check with your company or your benefits to see if flu shots are offered. Most employers cover flu shots at 100% under their preventive medical benefits.

**10. I work part-time. Can I get a flu shot at no cost?**

Yes, part-time and casual employees are eligible to redeem a CVS voucher for flu shots.
